

## Ulemu.com's Membership Fee Structure

For residents of Chisi Island, **100 kwacha or €0.10 per child per week**, to support the:

- provision of nutritious meals at the island's pre-school nurseries, primary school and after-school homework club
- training of teaching assistants at the island's pre-school nurseries and primary school
- cost of transport for children referred for hospital appointments on the mainland
- testing and treatment of malaria cases on the island
- supply chain breaks of antibiotics needed at the island's health centre
- the payment of 80 percent of secondary school fees for islanders attending secondary school on the mainland

### Exemptions

- Households with more than three children attending pre-school, primary and/or secondary school, will only be expected to pay 300 kwacha (or €0.30) per week.
- Households considered by their village chief and/or Ulemu.com community volunteers may have their membership fees temporarily reduced or waived fees.

For non-residents of Chisi Island, **100,000 kwacha or €100 per year**, to:

- subsidise the services listed above that benefit Chisi Islanders
- finance Ulemu.com's other operating costs listed in its Strategic Plan (2023-2024) and on <https://www.ulemu.com/projectsandactivities>
- have access to the Ulemu.com WhatsApp Accounts group where they can follow the spending of the Association's funds
